

# BATHROOM CLEANING CHECKLIST

## STEP 1: YOU NEED

Bathroom Spray/Disinfectant, Reusable Gloves, Clean old T-shirt or towels to use as rags, Vacuum Cleaner, Bucket, Mop, Washing up Liquid, Vinegar, Bicarbonate Soda, Boxes or bags for decluttering, Glass cleaning polish.

## STEP 2: SKIRTING BOARDS, FRAMES & FLOOR

1. Sweep/vacuum floor and skirting boards to remove the dirt.
2. Fill bucket 1/4 with warm water & 1/2 teaspoon washing up liquid
3. Wipe the skirting boards using a clean rag with the soapy water. Repeat with warm clean water.

## STEP 3: CABINETS

1. Remove all products, wipe, sort according to 'immediate use', store 'future use' or donate/throw away.
2. Wipe inside of cabinets with warm soapy water and then repeat with clean warm water.
3. Leave to dry.
4. Place all immediate use products back. **TIP:** Don't forget to use up what you store for future use.

## STEP 4: SINKS, BATHTUBS & SHOWER CUBICLES

1. Remove all products from the surfaces, sort as per step 2.
2. Spray all areas with the correct bathroom cleaning sprays.
3. Leave for a few minutes, then wipe with warm clean water and clean rag. Use a soft bathroom brush to scrub the tiles.
4. Use an old toothbrush to clean around taps and hard to reach areas.
5. Place all immediate use products back. **TIP:** Keep as little on display as possible - minimalist look.

## STEP 5: TOILET

1. Spray disinfectant on the toilet walls, leave for 5 minutes, then repeat Step 2.
2. Spray inside of the toilet with a toilet bowl cleaner, leave 1 hour, then scrub with a toilet brush & flush.
3. For stains, soak toilet roll paper in vinegar and bicarbonate soda and place on top of the stains, leave for a few hours, then spray with water and wipe it away.

## STEP 6: FINISHING TOUCHES

1. Use a window cleaning spray and a clean rag to polish the mirror and glass.
2. Vacuum the floor one more time.
3. Place fresh towels in the bathroom.
4. Place a small plant near the window to give it a natural feel.
5. Place only 1 scented candle or essential oil in the bathroom to give it a final touch of luxury. **TIP:** If you are feeling inspired, give your bathroom a new paint job to bring it back to life.
